Meeting Minutes for Dec 16, 2023 Grand Strand Scale Modelers

December's meeting was held at the Socastee County Library starting at 10:00 AM, Dec 16th. There were **15** hungry members in attendance.

- Rick called the meeting to order:
 - Rick welcomed all members and asked if anyone had pressing issues to add to the meeting's agenda.
 - Ballot items were briefly discussed and were available for clarification. No issues were raised so voting proceeded. The votes are IN!! (More Later...)
 - BeachCon Flyer Change was required due to the usage of copyrighted artwork.

• BeachCon 24 Report

- Additional acrylic trophy was designed and sent to Michigan for lasering. There will be an award for *Best Art & Collections* for the "Miscellaneous" categories (801-803).
- CyberModeler: We are NOW listed as a contest on their Event Calendar!!
- Chaz is working on artwork for signage. All signage will be sustainable and can be used for many years into the future.
- Chaz asked for a show of hands of anyone who shops at ScaleHobbyist.com as he plans to pursue them as a sponsor.
- The cost to rent 8 foot rectangular tables is becoming prohibitive. If anyone has access to any 8 foot tables from a church/school we are willing to pay a nominal fee of \$7-8.00.
- Phil Cavender agreed to review the BeachCon layout to integrate both round and rectangular tables.
- Storage and transport could be performed by a loaned van....or U-Haul. May require assistance for pick-up and return.....any volunteers?
- BeachCon GSSM Sales Table was briefly addressed with at least 4 members interested in selling their unbuilt kits. One or two tables and staffing will be addressed soon. One issue for anyone wishing to sell; please include a Top Price and a Bottom Price for each kit. This will keep staff from having to chase you down for price confirmation.

• Other Stuff

- "Shelf Queen Management": Have your Shelf Queen Group Build kit ready for January's meeting (Jan 20, 2024)!!
- Ed's Hobby Shop: is OPEN!! Ed's Hobby Shop 1804 N Main St, Conway, SC 29527. A couple of GSSM member had visited. There is more room so there may be a possibility of GSSM presenting or performing a build day in the future.
- Socastee Library
 - We are planning to have a BeachCon display for the month of February 2024. March is unavailable. Chaz has scheduled (tentavily) the display cabinet in the foyer.
 - It was addressed and agreed that GSSM will make a \$100 donation to the Library's "Play Ground" fund. GSSM gives back. This will be performed after BeachCon and the coffers are full again.....
- **Next Group Build** will be voted on by GSSM members during January meeting. The on-deck circle contains *"Road Rage"* and *"Not Another Messerschmidt"* as the next ones up (12 votes each). Though the timing is *TBD* (June?) the next Group Build should be one of these.
- **GSSM as a Multi-Media Meeting** option and logistics will be investigated by Chaz as some GSSM members are now out of state and would enjoy the option. The primary key will be the

library's web communication abilities as well as local equipment. There were no dissenting votes. Stay "tuned".....as this will go into exploratory stage.

- Clear the Shelf Stash Sale A quick reminder that all members agreed that GSSM would have a "Clear the Shelf Stash Sale" during the January meeting. Any more than that and we'll call it robbery......errrr...taxes.....

Using <u>Scalemates</u> as a paint color/research resource:

For example, I was looking for who's paint products would match a color for an upcoming build. The closest color match that I found is FS 32246 (Federal Standard 595a). You'll find a dropdown listbox on the upper right portion of the Scalemates home page. If you depress the list, you will be presented with a myriad of

options to choose from. Select "Paints" and enter "FS32246". The results will present a couple of colors to choose from. If you select Vallejo's 70.956 – Clear Orange the resulting page will show you a larger image of the color, however, keep scrolling. The resulting list covers all the Enamels, Acrylics, Lacquers...etc.. that closely match the color selected.
