Meeting Minutes for April 26th 2025 Grand Strand Scale Modelers

Many kits were picked up but there are plenty left for anyone with a serious plastic fetish. We made approx. \$540 in sales which goes some way to recoup the money invested. Remaining kits were distributed to the club members as we have no one central source of storage.
 - Rick has also obtained another group of kits which he will offer at a discounted rate to the group shortly, just must get the details together.
 - Vote was taken on hosting BeachCon 2026, unanimous decision to go ahead with the yearly event. Democracy in action!
