a new B-25J. This is a welcome addition as the only other kit out there is the very old Monogram boxing.




Zoukei-Mura

A 32nd scale Bf 109-G14. This kit has the typical detail expected of a ZM kit.





Earl brought in a 35 scale Tamiya Stuart M5A1. He used the kit figures, am a Tiger Werks base.






Earl also brought in a hobby Boss 48th scale BV-141. Looking forward to seeing this one built. Only 101 window panes,




Phil S brought in a Tamiya Jeep. He used AK weathering perils



- · Awards will be presented for the top three (Gold/Silver/Bronze) per category
- · No restriction on number of entries per category
- There will be a MODIFIED no sweeps rule for each category (2/3)
- Two Best of Show awards (Automotive and Non-Automotive (Military/Sci-Fi/Figure/etc.)
- Previous models having placed First (Gold) or Best of Show are not eligible to compete
- Entries will be checked for proper category placement and moved, as necessary, before judging
- Models requiring more than 4 sq ft and/or weighing more than 30lbs may not be allowed to enter based upon available space. Please contact us before bringing the model
- Junior entries are FREE to register
- Reasonable care and protection will be provided for entries by the Hosts and the Judges; however, Hosts cannot
 assume responsibility in the event of loss or damage
