 - Vendor Room

 - Additional Training for Judging: Mike F & Rick agreed to ensure that additional training and discussions will take place during the 2023/24 cycle so we're all ready for the contest.
 - Raffle Discussion Topics:
 - Duncan was added to the Phil Sicard/Dayne team.
 - Phil Sicard will utilize his garage for stockpiling of raffle Items.
 - All going to Columbia contest (17th June) would participate in the raffle for acquisition of kits/items, for BeachCon24 raffle items.

 - o GSSM Club Table(s) For sale of unwanted kits. All members may participate. Needs to be "manned".

The Treasurer's report was given by Phil Cavender. Closing balance was \$3167.97.






